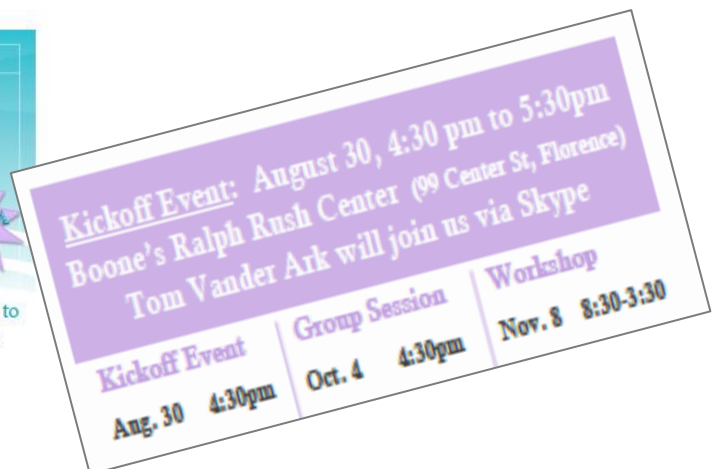
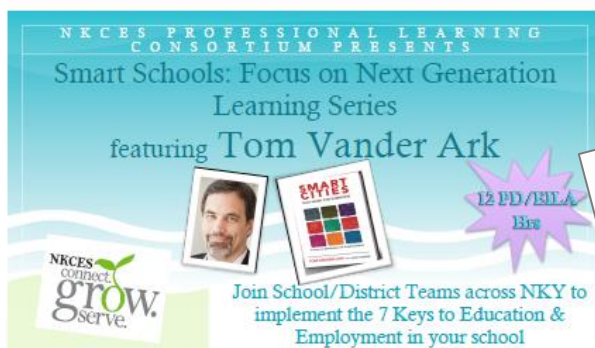

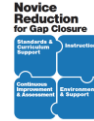
7 PROGRAM REVIEW RUBRICS WEBINAR
